



Immunization and Prescription Requirements

To travel to Niger with Effective Ministries, Inc. (EMI), each team member is required to fully comply with our immunization and prescription requirements. We take the health and well-being of our teams seriously and will not allow team members to travel without proper protection. It is the desire of our ministry to help ensure each team member has a safe and meaningful mission experience. Our EMI office can provide information on locations for procuring these immunizations and prescriptions. Please be aware that your health insurance may cover only a limited amount of the cost.

Below is the list of required immunizations and prescriptions compiled in accordance with CDC guidelines and the counsel of BetterMed Occupational Health Foreign Travel Clinic. This information is based on current in-country conditions and is subject to change.

IMPORTANT: All immunizations must be completed at least one month prior to your departure to Niger to ensure maximum protection.

IMMUNIZATIONS

- Tetanus (Td)
- Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (TDaP)
- Hepatitis A
- Hepatitis B
- Meningococcal
- Adult Polio Booster *(for all travelers over the age of 18)*
- Yellow Fever *(required by the Nigerien government to enter the country)*
- Typhoid
- Covid-19 Vaccine (OR)
Positive SARS-CoV-2 Antibody Blood Test **(within 3 months of departure)**

PRESCRIPTIONS

- Malarone – For Malaria *(Due to side effects, LARIAM is NOT allowed)*
- Azithromycin (Zithromax Z-Pac) For Traveler's Diarrhea & Sinus Infections
